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- We switched from grade level funding to grants. We have only given out 1 grant to 4th grade for Study Island. We are concerned that it is not being utilized. There are some concerns. We also cannot use grants for fieldtrips, buses, conferences, etc.
- Students need a teacher sponsor for a grant.
- The first student grant was for a gaming club. They asked for PS5 and switches. They asked for too much and needed a sponsor. They also need to tie it to student achievement. Also, what liabilities are there?
- It was discussed as to why teachers are not applying for grants. Classroom teachers can do an individual (\$650) AND a group grant (\$1500) AND be a Sponsor.
